



Facts about Landfolk rental insurance

In cooperation with Landfolk, Tryg has developed an insurance solution that covers you as booker of a summer house on www.landfolk.com. The insurance covers damages that are accidentally made by you or your guests on things and building parts during the rental period – thereby providing you with security.

Rental insurance

When you book a summer house through www.landfolk.com, you are insured if you or your pet accidentally damage the host's private things that are located in the summer house during the entire rental period.

The insurance also covers if you or your pet accidentally damage the summer house itself. This provides security both for you as guest as well as for the host.

The maximum compensation amount is DKK 100.000 in total during the rental period. For damages made by pets the maximum compensation amount is DKK 10.000.

As guest you have a deductible of DKK 1.500 per damage regardless of whether you or your pet causes the damage.

When is it an accident?

If you as guest, for instance, knocks something over that gets partially or completely damaged during the rental period.

It is a requirement for coverage that you can present documentation of the damage.

Practical information

Reporting a damage

You report a damage by contacting Landfolk, who subsequently sends you a link to Tryg's digital claims form. When you have filled in and submitted the claims form, it is automatically sent to Tryg who hereafter will process the claim.

Tryg reserves the right to request any information necessary to process the claim.
